Every week a show from Taiwan is played on San Francisco's KTSF Channel 26 that features amateur magicians judged by professionals such as Lu Chen (http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Lu_Chen). The show, generally broadcast on Sunday evenings from 6:30-8:30 is sort of like AMERICA'S GOT TALENT . The first half tends to be comedy, music and wacky acts with the second half tending to focus on magic.

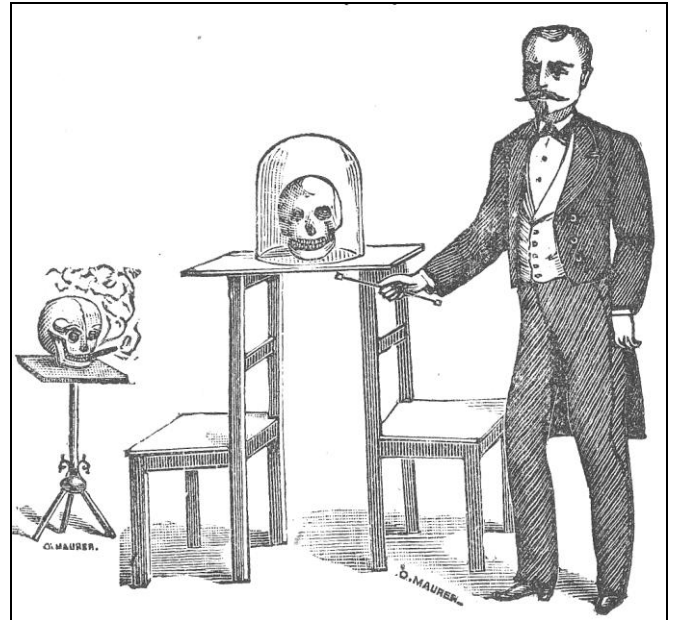
